Cedar Hedge Top Cut at Trillium Gardens Today



Rempel Landscaping is on site today to begin the cutting of the cedars along the back yards of Parkside Drive and the surround to the entrance common garden beds.

Today begins a two-step process to arrive at the desired hedge height and shape.

Previously, the cedars have been trimmed but a height reset is required. The top cut will help thicken the cedar branches and tips at the bottom and start a practice of maintaining a more formal privacy hedge.

The hedge cut today involves using a chainsaw to cut the main stem down to an 8' height. It will look ragged until the new growth surrounds the top main stem. New growth this summer will cover the tips. Please be patient.

In early November, Rempel will be back to shape the tops and sides during their fall landscape prune and cleanup. This second cut will not be as noticeable over the winter but will prepare the cedars for the spring growing season.

Rempel is cleaning up the cedar tips and tops as they go along but there will be some debris left behind.
